Dear Mr. Wessler:

As you know, your request (the "Request") submitted for the records regarding the City of Sunrise (the "City") was received by the City on June 3, 2014. The Request seeks records in the following categories: (1) records regarding the City's policies and procedures regarding the City's records pursuant to the Florida Freedom of Information Act, Chapter 119, Florida Statutes.

Your request for documents and information is extensive, and will require extensive review of information by the City, which may require the assistance of personnel of the City to identify and locate the records. In accordance with the City's policy, we will impose a duplication charge for copying public records and additional charges in accordance with the fee schedule enumerated in City Code Section 2-398 and Section 119.07(4), Florida Statutes. It is the City's policy that a deposit be submitted by you, equal to the anticipated cost of the assembly and duplication before processing will commence, particularly where clerical services of an extensive nature are necessary.

Having reviewed the request and the records responsive to the request, the City has determined that the required work to review the records would be performed, the following:

(a) A total time of 1.195 hours at a rate of \$13.55 per hour (with no charge for the first 30 minutes), totaling \$16,185.48; and

(b) A 25% factor reflecting the cost of the records.

If there are any changes to the estimate of your request in any way, please let me know and we will provide a corresponding updated estimate.

Pursuant to City Code Section 2-308(a), if the request is temporary, you are responsible for the additional amount. At your convenience, you may submit a check in the amount of \$26,131.85 payable to the City of Fort Lauderdale. Zeskind, Weiss Serota Helfman, P.A., 200 Fort Lauderdale Blvd., Suite 1900, Fort Lauderdale, Florida 33301. The City will begin processing your request as soon as your deposit has been received.
