Medicaid is a health insurance program for very low-income people who meet certain guidelines. Medicaid also provides insurance coverage for long term care, such as we someone needs nursing home care. Many states have additional specific programs that also called Medicaid, such as pre-natal care coverage for pregnant women.

Each state has its own Medicaid program that is partially funded by the federal government Most states call this program "Medicaid," but some states have their own name for the Medicaid program (for example, in California it is called Medi-Cal). Each state has di erent rules about who can get Medicaid and what is covered, although there are som federal requirements that states must all follow.
